- 5. Defendant Foote is not a member of the United States military. Attached as Exhibit B is an affidavit regarding defendant Foote's military status.
- 6. The damages claimed in Plaintiff Mancia's petition are unliquidated. The court held a hearing by submission where Plaintiff Mancia presented affidavits proving his damages.
 - 7. This judgment is final, disposes of all claims and all parties, and is appealable.
 - The court orders execution to issue for this judgment. 8.
