DECLARATION OF JONATHAN SANFORD REGARDING RAZOR BLADES

DECLARATION OF

1. My name is Jonathon Sanford, AIS# 225417 am above the age of 19 years.
2. I am currently in the custody of the Alabama Department of Corrections ("ADOC").

3. I am housed at Bullock Correctional Facility in Dorm C-1. This is a mental health dorm in the main building. I was previously housed in dorm H-2 in the Mental Health Building

4. I am required to shave everyday.

5. Inmates in Dorm C-1 can go to the laundry and get a razor everyday from the inmate worker. Sometimes the ADOC laundry attendant is present.

6. Inmates in C-1 can also go to the officer in the dorm and request a razor. Inmates can ask this officer for a razor multiple times a day. If the officer has a razor, he will give it to the inmate. These are the plastic safety razors.

7. Inmates in C-1 can also buy (1) pack of 3 BIL razors off the canteen each week.

8. The metal screw top razors are still in population and being used by some inmates

9. Inmates in C-1 do not have to turn in a razor blade to get another one. There is no other process of collection of razor blades at Bullock Correctional Facility.

10. Inmates break open the plastic razors to use the blade for other things such as cutting paper and opening food packages.

11. Inmates break open the plastic razors to use the blade to cut themselves. Last Friday, Aug 22, 2014, an inmate broke a safety razor and used the loose blade to cut himself on the arm. This was at approx. 2:00 p.m. He was not taken to the hospital. He is now in lock-up. He told me he cut his arm because he was tired of the officers harassing him.

12. I have seen inmates break open the plastic razors to use the loose blade for a weapon. I have seen inmates use these loose blades to cut each other during fights.

13. Inmates have multiple razors in their property. I have seen inmates who have 3 or 4 packs of three BIC razors at a time. Officers do not care how many razors inmates have and do not collect the razors during searches.

14. I was a segregation worker in the Mental Health Building from 5/14 to 7/14. While I was cleaning these cells, I have found loose blades on the floor and under the mattresses of the Suicide watch cells and the disciplinary Segregation cells.

15. Razor blades are lying around all over the dorm. I have seen blades lying around on the beds, on the floor and in the bathroom area.
