I ordered Offender Killen, #112906, a second time to move out of my way so that I could depart the room. I told CID that you are messing with my bed you black bitch.", therefore, I administer one burst of chemical agent into his facial area to prevent any further advancement. Once the chemical agent was administered to Offender Killen, #112906, he moved back away from me allowing room for me to exit his room. I immediately returned to the Security Desk at the entrance of Unit 31, grabbed the radio and contacted Correctional Commander Tom Mitchell via the radio and requested that he come to Unit 31 A.S.A.P. At approximately 1145 hours, CC Mitchell along with Correctional Supervisor Shantel Pugh entered to assist with this incident. At approximately 1145 hours, I notified Unit 30 Control room Officer Gloria Robinson of this incident. At approximately 1146 hours, I notified the Area II Shift Commander, Correctional Commander Larry Belton of this incident. At approximately 1152 hours, Correctional Officer IV Henry James entered Unit 31 with the camera for CC Mitchell. At approximately 1215 hours, CO-IV James along with 52, Correctional Officer Mary Robertson departed with Offender Killen #112906, transporting him to Unit 42 for medical attention. 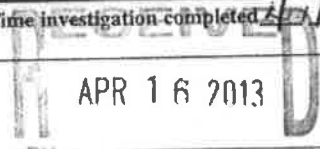
