FINAL DEFAULT JUDGMENT

- 4. Defendant Nethercott's last known address is 3333 West Puzzi Ranch Road, Douglas, Arizona, 85607. Attached as Exhibit A is a certificate of defendant Nethercott's last known address.
- 5. Defendant Nethercott is not a member of the United States military. Attached as Exhibit B is an affidavit regarding defendant Nethercott's military status.
- The damages claimed in Plaintiff Leiva's petition are unliquidated. The court 6. held a hearing by submission where Plaintiff Leiva presented affidavits proving her damages.
 - 7. This judgment is final, disposes of all claims and all parties, and is appealable.
 - The court orders execution to issue for this judgment. 8.
