The federal court overseeing the *P.B. v. Brumley* case (formerly known as *P.B. v. White*) is holding a special hearing to hear directly from families. The consent judgment that has protected students with disabilities for years may be ending — and the judge wants to hear from you before making a decision.

You'll have a chance to briefly share your story or concerns with the judge. The SPLC, as class counsel, is available to help you prepare your statement and attend the hearing.
